

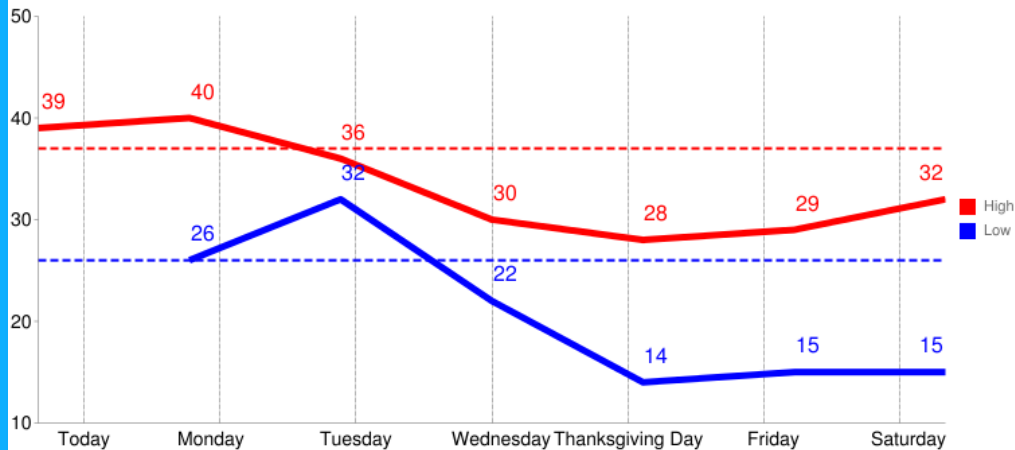

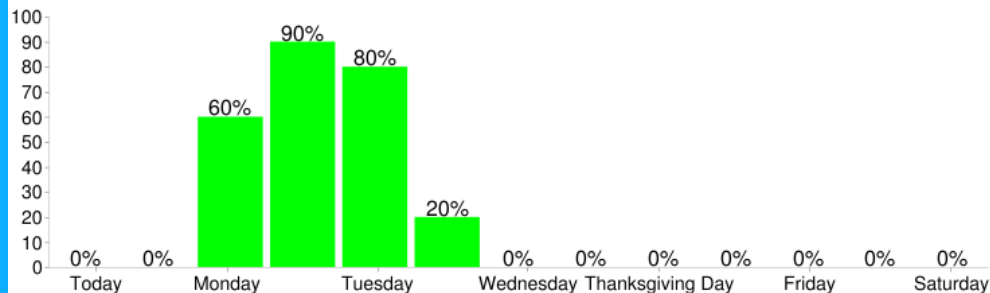
November 22, 2015 Weather Update

Chance of Precipitation



First 72 Hours

- Highs near 40° Sun and Mon
- Snow/Rain Monday evening and Tuesday
- Temperatures Dropping Wednesday
- Challenging snow forecast

Beyond 72 Hours

- Cold and Dry

0.3" - 3.0"

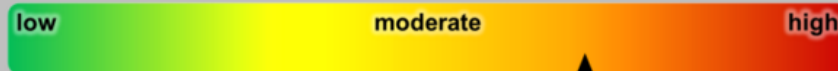
Average Value

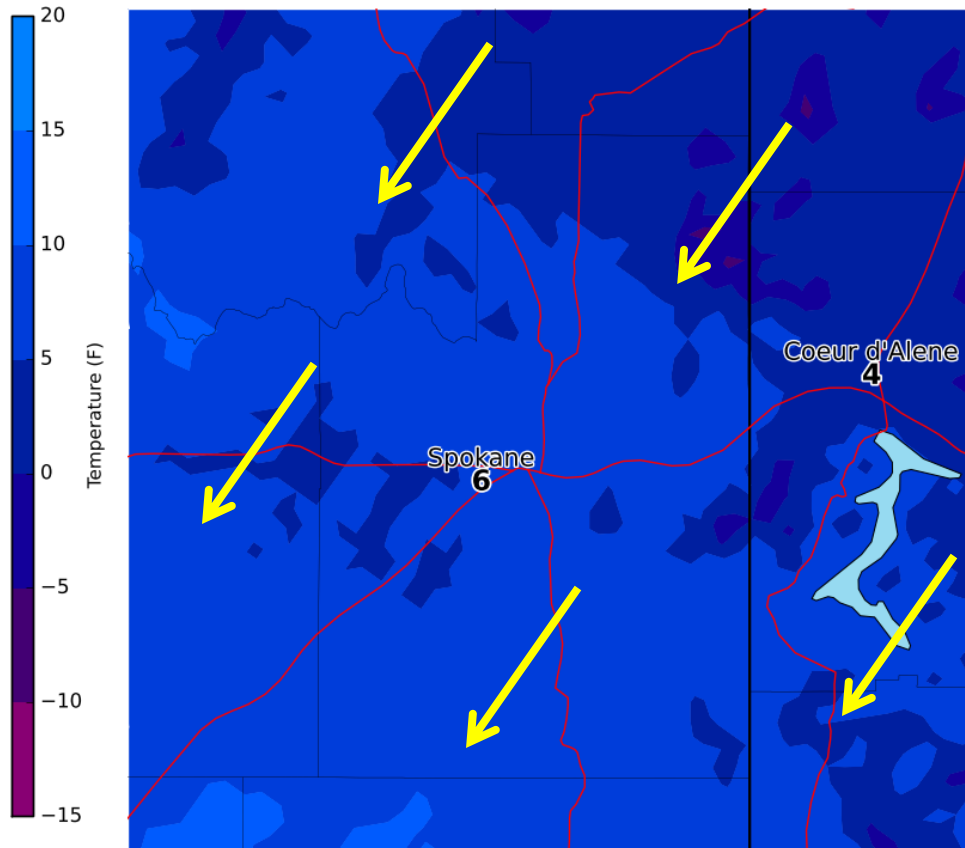

Valid: Wednesday, November 25, 2015 at 07 AM PST

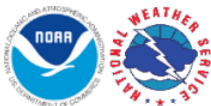


Wind Chill

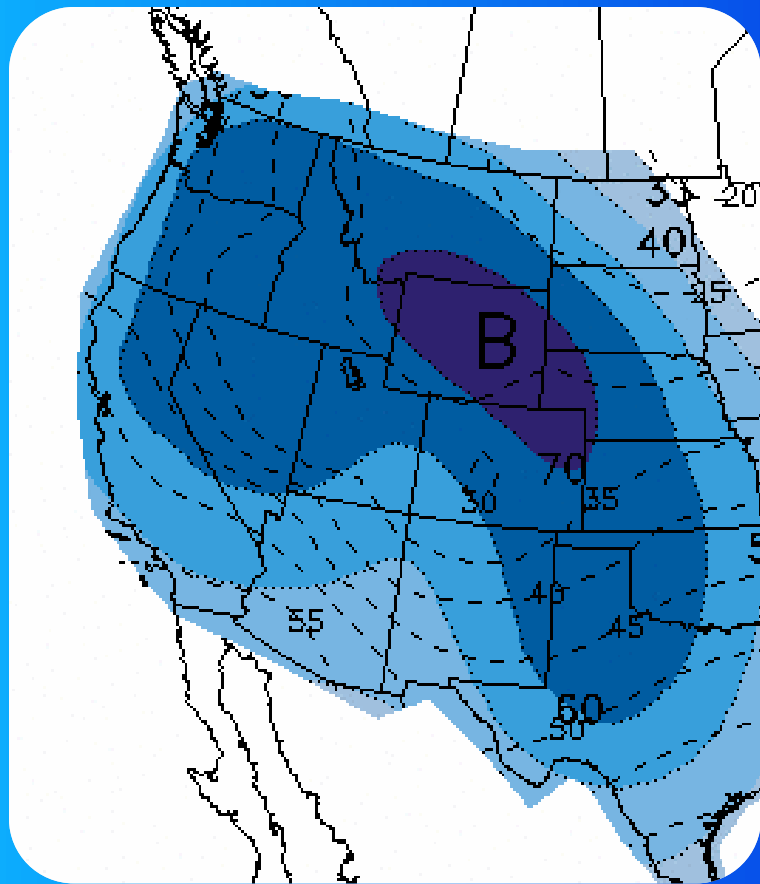
Climate Prediction Center's 6-10 Temperature Outlook

Valid Nov 27-Dec 1, 2015

- High Confidence that temperatures will continue to be colder than "normal"

- No other storms looming after the Nov 24-25th event

- "Normal" for this time of year is
Highs near 40°
Lows in the upper 20s°
